

CISM Parachuting

CISM Parachuting Championships consist of three disciplines: Precision Accuracy, Speed Style, and 4 Way Relative Work. Personnel applying to compete in CISM Parachuting Championships must meet the below listed requirements:

- a. Be on active duty for all evaluations, training camps and competitions.
 - 1) First evaluation will be conducted at Laurinburg DZ, NC the first week in April of each competition year. If unable to attend this evaluation, please contact SFC Morrison at (910) 907-3205/3206 to discuss alternate options.
 - 2) Additional training camp dates will be announced following the April evaluations.

- b. Equipment Requirements: Personnel must provide all essential equipment:
 - 1) Precision accuracy parachute (Para-Foil or Classic)
 - 2) Small free-fall system for doing free-fall formation skydiving
 - 3) Accuracy, Style, and Relative Work jump suits
 - 4) AAD (automatic activation device) on all free-fall systems
 - 5) Altimeter

- c. Performance Requirements: All personnel must be able to compete in Precision Accuracy, Speed Style, and Free-Fall formation parachuting. Minimum performance standards are as follows:
 - 1) Men: Accuracy: achieve 0.15 centimeter total (or less) for 10 rounds
Speed Style: Perform 8 second style sets (judged).
Free-fall formation: be able to do minimum of 18 points per round

 - 2) Women: Accuracy: achieve 0.20 centimeter total (or less) for 10 rounds
Speed Style: Perform 10 second style sets (judged).
Free-fall formation: be able to do a minimum of 16 points per round
