

## CISM Shooting

CISM shooting Championships consist of two disciplines, rifle and pistol and is gender specific: Men's Rifle is a 300 Meter event composed of a Precision event and a Rapid Fire event. Women's rifle is a 50 Meter event and is composed of prone event and a 3 position event. Men's and women's pistol events are all at 25 Meters however men use a center fire pistol and women use a sport pistol. CISM shooting is governed by the current CISM shooting regulations ([http://www.cism-milspport.org/eng/b1\\_sport/b1\\_regulations\\_PDFs/Shooting.pdf](http://www.cism-milspport.org/eng/b1_sport/b1_regulations_PDFs/Shooting.pdf)) and the ISSF shooting rules (<http://www.issf-shooting.com>). Personnel applying to compete in CISM Shooting Championships must meet the below listed requirements:

- a. Be on active duty for all evaluations, training camps and competitions.
  - 1) Tryouts will be conducted at Fort Benning, GA at a time to be determined by the US Army Marksmanship Unit (AMU) for each competition year and announced by armed forces sports.
  - 2) For the most up to date information please contact Mr. Mike Behnke at 706 545 7841 to discuss alternate options.
  - 3) Training camps may be announced following the tryouts for those that are selected.
  - 4) Comply with the World Anti Doping Code (WADA).

b. Equipment Requirements: Ideally personnel must provide all essential equipment, but may be provided depending on what is available at the AMU:

- 1) Rifles or pistols (can use AMU weapons while at the AMU)
- 2) Shooting clothes and equipments (depends on what is avail)
- 3) Ammunition (CISM team members can be issued ammunition, but must pick up at the unit, will not ship)

c. Performance Requirements: All personnel interested must be able to meet minimum performance standards are as follows:

- 1) Rifle: Precision Men 300m – 565  
Rapid Fire Men 300m – 550  
Prone Women 50m – 585  
3 Position Women 50m -- 565
- 2) Pistol: Precision Men 25m – 570  
Rapid Fire Men 25m – 570  
Precision Women 25m – 565  
Rapid Fire Women 25m – 565
