SUBJECT: Release of Department of Defense (DoD) Business Mission Area (BMA) Architecture Federation Strategy and Road Map Version 2.4.

This revised Guidance should be used together with the DoD *GiG Federation Strategy* dated August 2007, and tools issued by the Business Transformation Office including: *Business Enterprise Architecture (BEA) Compliance Guidance* dated April 2006, the *Business Transformation Guidance (BTG)* dated July 2007 and the *BEA CONOPS* dated September 2007.

Through these documents, and the directives governing the Defense Business Systems Management Committee / Investment Review Boards (DBSMC/IRB's), the Architecture Federation guidance will achieve sustainment within the BMA as a result of the efforts of the Core Business Missions (CBM's) and the Components, Services and Agencies (C/S/A's) to maintain architectural linkage to the BEA within the principle of Tiered Accountability.

Included in this Guidance is reference to the Federal Enterprise Architecture (FEA) and Business Transformation Agency (BTA) Guidance for architecture compliance within the Business Capability Lifecycle (BCL) and IRB processes, and details outlining the role of the Business Operating Environment (BOE) within the evolving DoD Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) supporting Net Centricity.

The "Business Mission Area (BMA) Architecture Federation Strategy and Road Map" is to be used by Program Managers and C/S/A Business Systems Architects as additional information in support of Pre-Certification Authorities for assessing compliance to the BEA and the establishment of SOA services which may be shared by the DoD enterprise.
